Justified paragraph with line break to force justification:

أَحِبُّ ائِوَّاهُ سَلَامٌ قَلَمٌ مَدْفَرٌ قَوْعًا

Same paragraph, unjustified:

أَحِبُّ ائِوَّاهُ سَلَامٌ قَلَمٌ مَدْفَرٌ قَوْعًا

Notice how the the justification increases inter-word space, but does not elongate the "pen" strokes of the actual words.

## Arabic

Justified paragraph with line break to force justification:

أَنَا أَحِبُّ التَّطْوِيلَ

Same paragraph, unjustified:

أَنَا أَحِبُّ التَّطْوِيلَ

Notice how the the justification elongates the "pen" strokes of the actual words. This is "tatweel", or "elongation".
